Once paid for, eCards will be placed in lyour instructor account to issue to students. This will allow you to make spelling or email changes as well as resend eCards to students who did not claim in the 2 week period following the eCard being issued.

We would prefer a credit card on account and we will send you the authorization to have saved on *Square* if you wish to go that way.

Once your eCards are issued, download the xI spreadsheet of names and emails addresses to save with your roster. AHA requires us to keep for 3 years so find a place on your computer to save those files.



## Recent highlights

AHA has added new PALS and ACLS Plus eLearning modules to expand your portfolio. They contain **Pediatric Advance Life Support**: Post cardiac Arrest, Sedation and Analgesia, Technology Dependent Child, Toxicology, Child Abuse and Airway Management. They are offered on the eLearning.heart.org website and are \$20.00 each.

Usually take about an hour to complete and CE is awarded which helps many fill in those extra hours required for certification and licensure.

Advanced Cardiac Life Support topics include Respiratory Emergencies, High Performance teams, Maternal Cardiac Arrest, Procedural Sedation, Advanced ECG, Opioid, Trauma, Post Cardiac Arrest Care, Mechanical Circulatory Systems, and Advanced Airway management. There is also ACLS prep classes in a bundle (ECG and Pharmacology) for \$35.00 or separately for \$20.00. Highly recommend for review and new students.



### We asked for and it's Here

Heartsaver Blended Learning in Spanish for both CPR AED (20-1470) \$15.00 and First Aid (20-1472) \$19.50. This audience now can be served in blended learning as well as classroom led classes. Materials for classroom can be customize to include your instructor manual, student workbook and your selection for course videos of DVD, USB or Digital formats.

Coupled with the BLS Spanish materials and exam (if you need, contact us), we can continue to expand training in those areas.

We also asked for Clarification for Heartsaver Targeted Audiences. The two paths of Heartsaver included Basic and Total. Students requiring the basic course for job requirements but do not require training to meet OSHA requirements can take the blended learning or in class course to be prepared to act in an emergency.

Those students required to take the course for specific job rqiiemtns which require OSHA compliance will take the Total course which is a common path taken by many agencies to meet their credentialing and industry guidelines. This class is available on line for blended format as well as classroom led.

Instructor Courses: There has been some condusion on instructor courses, who can teach them and what is required. You must be:

- Training Faculty in the discipline you wish to teach the instructor class. Note: This requires an application and orientation and is an appointment made by this TC.
- Have taken the current Instructor Essentials in the discipline that wish to teach.
- Reviewed and completed a phone orientation to the materials with our Training Consultant.
- There is NOT an AHA online course for instructors apart from the Instructor Essential Course. The instructor class is conducted in the classroom with course monitoring to follow.
